This short, fun race (run, walk, or be assisted on our course, about the length of a football field) and its associated warm-up and after-run activities have been designed specially for people of all ages


with special needs. The race is conducted in a safe environment for people with disabilities.


Our participants with special needs enjoy the same amenities and
