The Sean Patrick French Memorial Scholarship Fund was created by the family of Sean Patrick French following his tragic death as a passenger in an underage drunk driving car wreck on January 1, 2002 and is administered by the Berkshire Taconic Community Foundation. Sean was a very popular junior at Chatham High School, had many running buddies throughout Section II, was an honor roll student and a record-setting runner.

Winners, selected by a 5-person review panel, will be announced in February and recipients will be recognized at Sean's Run at Chatham High School.

The Scholarship Fund is administered by the Berkshire Taconic Community Foundation. In addition to the "Good Sportsmanship" Scholarships for runners from Section II, the Fund also supports the "Love of Running" Scholarships for high school runners from Columbia County and Community Service Scholarships for seniors graduating from Chatham High School.
